Updates since last meeting

- We have a name: <u>Planetary Research</u>. Second place goes to Planetologica.
- We have a domain name and a pre-launch journal website: https://planetary-research-journal.online
- Funding: still trying to organize a meeting with the Université Paris Cité president.
- Contacted CNRS, and they seem to be willing to provide a support of 10 k€ for the first year. We will submit a 3 page proposal in two weeks. (If you were an editor or AE, let me know in the forum for the proposal).
- Need to look into European funding. It is not clear which program we would apply to (Horizons --- Research infrastructure?).

Creation of a non-profit organization

- There is no problem having a non-profit own the journal (as opposed of the university). Ownership by a non-profit would make it easier to move to a different partner later (the ISSN would be registered in the name of the organization).
- We would create a French 1901 association, which is fairly easy. The steering committee of the journal would act as the de facto board of the association.
- We could apply for grants, have a bank account, wouldn't pay TVA, and could ask for donations.
- If the association had sufficient funding, we could consider paying a small honorarium for certain positions (like editors).
- The association would run the journal, journal blog, and potentially the solarsytem.online mattermost, mastodon, and peertube video servers.

All things editors

- Expected workload of editors: 2 new manuscripts per month?
- Number of editors: 4? 5? 6?
- Number of articles per year: 2*12*5 20% rejections = ~100
- Should the editor-in-chief oversee manuscripts? Time permitting? Less than 1 new manuscript per month?
- Associate editors: 10? Required to increase the expertise base of the editorial board. If the associate editors handle reviewer contact and provide an assessment, this could allow the editors to handle more than 2 manuscripts per month.

Editor search

- Announce editor-in-chief, editor, and associate editor positions one week before LPSC (PEN email list, Europlanets newsletter, Europlanets discord, OpenPlanetary slack, lunar listserver, French PNP newsletter, what else?)
- Draft announcement on forum.
- Applications (CV, publication list, short letter) sent to the search committee chair.
- The search committee will evaluate applications, but will also need to proactively encourage qualified candidates to apply.
- July 1 deadline for applications? Editorial board should be in place September.
- Who wants to be on the search committee?

Media team

- Journal Logo. How to proceed?
- Creation of social media accounts: Bluesky and Mastodon. Threads? Facebook?
 Instagram? LinkedIn? Youtube? WeChat? What else?
- Design of the journal blog website. Need to pick a CMS (Wordpress?) and a theme.
- Blog content. Author provided (4 paragraph + figure) article summaries. Figure
 of the week, space art or sketch of the week. What else? Conference/meeting
 summaries? Job postings? Book reviews? Planetary news?

Forum questions:

- Should associated editors be formally named on the manuscript? *Anonymous by default? If they sign their name, it would be noted in the review report.*
- Should we use CRediT taxonomy for author contributions?
- Should there be a similar CRediT-like taxonomy for what the Associate Editor did? (Such as choosing and contact reviewers, assessing reviews, providing and independent assessment, etc.)
- Journal scope: Should we consider "simulation papers"? (such as mission simulations)
- Should a 4 paragraph plus figure article summary for the blog be mandatory, instead of having a mandatory plain language summary?
